



Refinery, Contractors and Mullen Crane & Transport Deliver Another Quality Turnaround

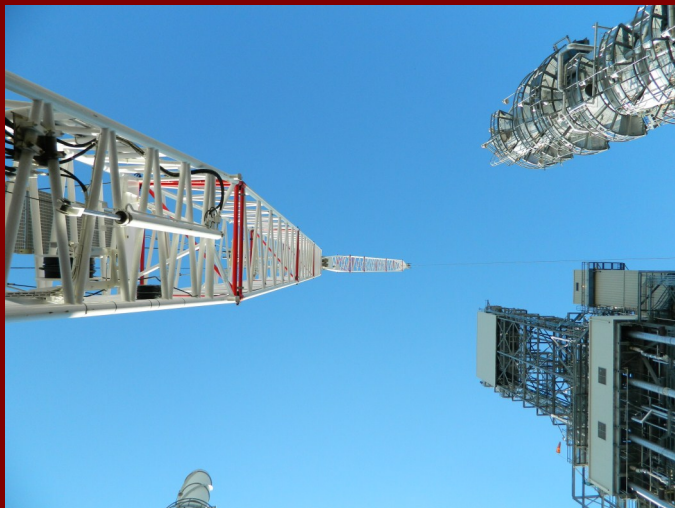
